The Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (CORE MPO), formerly known as the Chatham Urban Transportation Study (CUTS), is the transportation planning agency for the Savannah urbanized area. CORE MPO invites you to review and provide comments on several proposed amendments to the 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and the FY 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Comment period for the proposed LRTP/TIP amendments starts on Tuesday, June 9th, 2009. Copies of the draft documents are available for review at all Live Oak Public Libraries and university libraries in Chatham County, the Chatham County-Savannah Metropolitan Planning Commission (MPC) offices, other public review agencies' offices as well as at the MPC website at www.thempc.org/transportation.htm. Updates to the draft documents will be posted on the website.

The CORE MPO also invites you to review and provide comments on project priorities for development of the FY 2010-2013 TIP which will list transportation improvement projects in Chatham County that are programmed to receive funds during the next four years.
