Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization To Hold A Public Information Meeting For State Route 21 Corridor Study

On Thursday, September 9, 2010 the Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (CORE MPO) will hold a Public Information Meeting concerning this proposed project in Chatham County. The CORE MPO is created by federal law to carry out the transportation planning activities for the Chatham County-Savannah urbanized area and is staffed by the Chatham County-Savannah Metropolitan Planning Commission. This is an American Recovery & Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funded project. The meeting will be held:

The purpose of the SR 21 Corridor Study is to define an alternative to improve mobility and to enhance the community along the corridor between I-516 and the Effingham County Line. The SR 21 Corridor Study objective is to evaluate alternatives for major capacity improvements to help alleviate congestion, accommodate future travel demand, improve safety, and enhance access to the Port and other major traffic generators. The study will evaluate the costs and benefits of alternatives with consideration of impacts on the environment and the community.

The meeting will be conducted between the hours of 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., and will include an overview of the project through a short presentation at 6:00 p.m. We will also share our timeline for completing the project and tell you how to stay involved. After the presentation, you are invited to interact one-on-one with the various team members and the CORE MPO.

The purpose of this meeting is to engage the community and to encourage public input into the decision-making process. This will be the first of a series of public outreach meetings to be held in the community. For project information contact:
