Resolution to Amend the FY 2011 Unified Planning Work Program of the Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (CORE MPO) To Add Additional L230 Funds for Strategic Transportation Studies

WHEREAS, in accordance with the joint Federal Transit Administration - Federal Highway Administration regulations on urban transportation planning (23 CFR Parts 420 and 450, and 49 CFR Part 613), a Unified Planning Work Program is required to be developed; and

WHEREAS, the Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (CORE MPO) has been designated by the Governor of Georgia as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Savannah urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, the Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization, in accordance with Federal requirements for a Unified Planning Work Program, and in cooperation with area planning, implementation, and operating transportation agencies, has developed a comprehensive transportation planning work program for the Savannah urbanized area for fiscal year 2011 which is specific by planning element and costs, and which combines all applicable funding sources; and

WHEREAS, the CORE MPO FY 2011 Unified Planning Work Program is consistent with all plans, goals, and objectives of the Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization; and

WHEREAS, the CORE MPO FY 2011 Unified Planning Work Program was initially adopted on April 28, 2010, amended on June 23, 2010, and subsequently amended on August 25, 2010 to include an additional \$25,000 in urban attributable funds (L230 funds) for strategic transportation studies.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization adopts the Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization FY 2011 Unified Planning Work Program as amended August 25, 2010 as its official program of transportation planning activities for the period from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011.
