It is the Petitioner's responsibility to submit permit plans to the Preservation Professional for Certificate of Appropriateness stamp prior to submitting them to Inspections.

**The green Certificate of Appropriateness approval must be posted at all times during construction in a location next to the building permit and clearly visible to the public.
