Mr. Jakob Von Trapp was present on behalf of the petition.

Ms. Sara Farr gave the staff report. The applicant is requesting after the fact approval for a mural at 2217 Bull Street. The mural was painted by a prior tenant and is a design that includes abstracts shapes as well as a house and profiles of faces.

Ms. Farr reported that staff recommends approval of the mural with the condition that a protective coating be added if one is not existing, because otherwise it meets the standards in the Master Plan and Guidelines for Markers, Monuments, and Public Art.

PETITIONER COMMENTS

Mr. Von Trapp stated that he purchased the property in 2014. A tenant approached him about putting his work over a tag. He said he informed the tenant that he was not sure they could do this. Tommy Lee took it upon himself and actually painted the mural. He has moved and this is the reason he is not present today to inform the HSMC what was his inspiration for the mural. Mr. Von Trapp said several people in the community approached him stating they believed the mural is a positive addition to their community and were hopeful that the mural could be kept there. Based on the many positive responses he received, he decided to go through the appropriate process and try to retroactively get the mural approved.

Mr. Von Trapp said he is prepared to add the protective coating as suggested by staff. He will get with staff regarding the protective coating.

COMMISSION DISCUSSION

The Commission discussed the mural. Mr. Gensheimer asked if this mural is on the lane side. Mr. Von Trapp explained that it is on 39th Street and Bull Street. Mr. Karatassos explained that this is not a lane, but Desoto Street. Dr. Henry asked what if someone wanted to white wash the building. Mr. Karatassos said this would be at the discretion of the property owner. If the owner wishes to change the mural,

he/she would have to submit another application to the HSMC to do so. The Commission discussed the purpose of the protective coating.
