5. Authorization of LRTP Amendment Process for I-16 Exit Removal and SR 21 Corridor Improvements

Ms. Jane Love explained that the projects resulting from the I-16 Flyover Removal Study and the SR 21 Corridor Study are not currently in the Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). Now that these studies are moving into the next phase these projects will need to be in the LRTP before they can be eligible for federal funding in the future. The amendment process is a 2-step process. Step 1 is to authorize the staff to fully review the projects, and then Step 2 is to report to the committee with specific project information and a proposal on whether to add it to the LRTP.

Ms. Harrison asked if there has been any public involvement with these two projects?

Ms. Love stated that there was a charrette in the I-16 Flyover Removal Study and there was a kick-off meeting for the SR 21 Corridor Study last year. There will be some additional public meetings regarding solutions for SR 21.
