Mr. Bob McGarry told the committee that Chairman James Aberson had said he couldn't make it today. Ms. Jane Love, of MPC/MPO, said the committee could choose a member to run the meeting in the Chairman's absence. The committee chose Ms. Love to run the meeting.

I. Approval of Agenda

1. Ms. Love explained that she'd like to remove the FY 2015-2018 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendments from the agenda. The reason was that there is going to be additional discussion before bringing it back for consideration. A motion was made and seconded to approve the agenda with the remove of the FY 2015-2018 TIP Amendments.

ACAT Action: the motion to approve the agenda with the removal of the FY 2015-2018 TIP Amendments carried with none opposed.

II. <u>Action Items</u>

2. Approval of the October 26, 2015 ACAT meeting minutes

Ms. Love read the minutes. It was moved and seconded to approve the minutes with a correction on an event location that Mr. Bob McGarry had announced at the end of the October meeting.

ACAT Action: the motion to approve the minutes of the October 26, 2015 ACAT meeting, with the correction on an event location Mr. Bob McGarry had announced, carried with none opposed.

3. Endorsement of the 2016 ACAT Meeting Schedule

Ms. Love read the dates proposed for ACAT meetings in 2016. It was moved and seconded to endorse the 2016 ACAT meeting schedule.

ACAT Action: the motion to endorse the 2016 ACAT meeting schedule carried with none opposed.

4. Endorsement of MPO Board Authorization to Process MTP Amendment for I-16 widening

Ms. Love explained that GDOT requested a long range plan amendment to add the widening of I-16. The first step if for the CORE MPO Board to authorized staff to proceed. After staff gathers the necessary information, the amendment can be considered for approval at a future meeting. Based on information so far, staff believes that this will not affect the financial balance of the plan, because GDOT proposes to move the federal funds from the Ogeechee Rd. project onto this project and then put state funds on the Ogeechee Rd. project to compensate. There was a question about why the shifting of funds is desirable. Ms. Love said that, other than possibility allowing faster work on Ogeechee Rd., she is not sure of the benefit at this time. She entertained a motion to endorse. It was moved and seconded to endorse the MPO Board Authorization to Process the MTP Amendment for I-16 widening.

ACAT Action: the motion to endorse the MPO Board Authorization to Process the MTP Amendment for I-16 carried with none opposed.

III. Status Reports

5. Status on the Update of the Participation Plan

Ms. Love said the Participation Plan is in the public comment period. MPO staff has worked on comments from state and federal planning partners, but has not received any comments from the public. This is about ready to be considered for endorsement. It will be brought back

in February because there is one more discussion among member of the technical committee happening the next day.

6. Update on the Metropolitan Transportation Plan Modification for Expanded Area

Ms. Love reviewed the purpose of the plan modification. Since the last status report in October, staff had met with the Richmond Hill staff to finalize the project list for that new part of the planning area. A draft addendum to the plan is being reviewed by federal and state planning partners. There will be a public comment period in January and then endorsement/approval considered in February.

7. CORE MPO Title VI Update

Ms. Love noted that the comments ACAT had made at the October meeting have been addressed in the draft that is still in the public comment period. She explained that the CORE MPO Title VI program will be put on the February agenda also because the Participation Plan, which is not being voted on until February, is part of the Title VI program.

IV. Agency Reports

A. CAT/Teleride

Ms. Marlana Williams reported that 21 of the 67 fixed route vehicles were out and that 10 of the 29 paratransit vehicles were out. Currently CAT is conducting re-certification of Teleride users who signed up in 2012. She announced CAT's next public meeting is the evening of December 9.

A few members said that Teleride drivers are not always getting the message that the rider is ready to return early if the driver happens to be in the area. Ms. Williams said that CAT is working to improve communication technology to the van drivers.
