Mr. Mark Egan called the meeting to order.

I. <u>Approval of Agenda</u>

It was moved and seconded to approve the agenda as presented.

CAC Action: the motion to approve the agenda carried with none opposed.

II. Action Items

A. Approval of June 16, 2011 meeting minutes

As there was no quorum at the June 16th meeting, there were no official meeting minutes to approve.

B. Endorsement of the revisions to the FY 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Ms. Wykoda Wang presented one major amendment and several administrative modifications to the committee. The amendment is to move the construction phase from FY 2012 to FY 2013 for the US 17 Bridge Replacement over Back River.. This has been delayed due to South Carolina environmental issues. The administrative modifications include the addition of project identification numbers from GDOT for six projects already in the TIP, correction of a typographical error from L230S funds to L230 funds, and minor project description changes submitted by Chatham County.

Ms. Wang noted that the major amendment requires a 15-day comment period, but the administrative modifications do not because the modifications do not change the funding or the schedule.

Mr. Egan opened the public hearing. There being no public comments, the public hearing was closed.

It was moved and seconded to endorse the revisions to the FY 2012-2015 TIP as presented by staff.

CAC Action: the motion to endorse the revisions to the FY 2012-2015 TIP as presented by staff carried with none opposed.

C. Endorsement of the amendment to the FY 2012 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

Mr. Mark Wilkes reported that this amendment to adjust the funding amount for L230 funds on the Strategic Planning task is necessary to make the UPWP consistent with the TIP which was adopted in June.

It was moved and seconded to endorse the amendment to the FY 2012 Unified Planning Work Program.

CAC Action: the motion to endorse the amendment to the FY 2012 Unified Planning Work Program carried with none opposed.

D. Endorsement of authorization of LRTP amendment process for I-16 exit removal and SR21 corridor improvements

Mr. Wilkes explained that these two projects were not included in the Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) during the last update. Now that these studies are moving into the next phase these projects need to <u>be</u> in the LRTP. The amendment process is a 2step process. Step 1 is to authorize the staff to fully review the projects and then report to the committee with specific project information. Step 2 will be staff's report at a future meeting after obtaining additional information. Approving Step 1 does not guarantee that the projects will be amended into the LRTP.

There was a discussion about the value of removing the I-16 exit ramp. . The I-16 study can be found on the MPO website.

It was moved and seconded to endorse the authorization for staff to study the I-16 exit removal and SR 21 for possible amendment to the LRTP.

CAC Action: the motion to endorse the authorization for staff to study the I-16 exit removal and SR 21 corridor improvement projects for possible amendment to the LRTP carried with one opposed.
