2. Briefing on MPC Natural Resources Protection Committee Activities

Bethany Jewell introduced several members of the Resources Protection Committee who were present for today's meeting. She said there have been several changes that have taken place in Savannah over the years that involved green space or open space. She also stated that the preservation and protection of these resources are of the importance because of their history and distinction. She referred the Board Members to several slides that she had prepared for their viewing.

Discussion

Mr. Lufburrow stated that he was in favor of the proposed partnerships to help conserve our natural resources. He said that the protection of these resources has been the responsibility of a few people in the past and that more people should be involved in the efforts in the future.

Patty McIntosh, Vice-President of Coastal Programs and Growth Management at the Georgia Conservancy, spoke briefly on the activities of the Natural Resources Protection Committee. She commended them on their efforts to permanently protect the endangered areas by implementing a formalized and comprehensive land protection program. She named several benefits of such a program; a) maintaining a clean and healthy water supply, b) maintaining healthy marsh eco-systems, c) improving air quality, and d) minimizing flood damage.

Mr. Thomson thanked the Natural Resources Committee and the MPC Staff that were involved in these efforts for their hard work in the implementation of this program.

3. Summary of Matrix for Unified Zoning Ordinance

Charlotte Moore stated that the matrix would better explain the existing or proposed approach. She referred the Board Members to the copy of the matrix provided to them in the handouts and pointed out several changes and updates that were made.

Discussion

Ms. Myers had questions regarding the change in the number of Members of the Landmark District Review Board. She stated that changing the number of Board Members would take away from the amount of input during discussions and limit the chances for having a more diverse group of members.
