**I. Welcome**

Meeting was called to order by Cam Mathis

**II. Action Items**

**A. Approval of Minutes**

**i. December 1, 2015 Minutes**

Motion to approve December 1, 2015 minutes were made and seconded. The meeting minutes were unanimously accepted.

**B. SAGIS Board Nominating Committee**

Jim Collins and Holmes Bell reported that Matt Gignilliat was willing to accept the nomination to chair the SAGIS Board for 2016. The motion was made, seconded, and unanimously accepted.

### **III. Report Items**

#### **A. Budget Report**

The end of year budget report from 2015 was presented. The budget report was also presented for the three months ending March 31, 2016.

#### **B. GIS Parcel Data Project**

A summary was provided for the status of the GIS Parcel Project by Lara Hall. At the end of 2015, it became apparent that additional funding was required for to complete the Chatham County Parcel Improvement Project with ITOS. SAGIS, MPC, City of Savannah, and Chatham County staff met multiple times to discuss how to proceed. Chatham County Commission approved an additional \$150,000 SPLOST funds to complete the parcel line improvements at the Jan. 15, 2016 meeting. MPC Board approved the execution of the additional Intergovernmental Agreement with Chatham County at the Feb. 23, 2016 meeting. Chatham County Engineering staff will oversee the completion of adjustments to annotation to match the improved parcel geometry. The final product is due October 2016.

#### **C. SAGIS Presentation**

##### **1. Summary**

Lara Hall presented a summary of the ongoing services that SAGIS provided to the community. SAGIS is a cooperative enterprise GIS between Chatham County, City of Savannah, Metropolitan Planning Commission, Georgia Tech – Savannah, and Georgia Power – Coastal Region. The SAGIS Mission is to consolidate geospatial information into one central location, providing access to all interested parties.

#### **Enterprise GIS**

- SAGIS provides access to a read only database with 550+ data layers shared with all City of Savannah and Chatham County departments. Each separate department maintains ownership for the editing databases. Additional agencies that participate in SAGIS include the Savannah Hilton Head Airport, the Savannah Chatham County Public School System, and Georgia Innovation Logistics Center.

#### **Internal Map Viewers**

- SAGIS provides a number of internal or private map viewers for the partnering agencies. These include the SAGIS iMap – general map viewer with over 550 data layers, Board of Assessors Viewer, Savannah-Hilton Head Airport Viewer, and the CEMA Viewer.

### **Public Data Access**

- SAGIS provides free and easy public access to the GIS and mapping data through the SAGIS.org website, the agency ArcGIS Online website, the SAGIS Open Data site and additional custom viewers as needed.

### **Project Management**

- SAGIS provides long term project management for the City and County, such as the parcel improvement project and the City and County redistricting following the 2010 Census. SAGIS also coordinates large dataset acquisition for county and city, such as imagery, planimetric data, and LIDAR.

### **Public Safety**

- SAGIS is the primary GIS support for Chatham Emergency Management Agency (CEMA). SAGIS also provides current location data for 911 dispatch through the road centerlines and the master address database. SAGIS also provides GIS support and mapping for police and fire departments as requested.

### **Education**

- SAGIS provides GIS education and support through a variety of methods in the county. The largest is the annual GIS Day Savannah event, held every November. This year marks the 10<sup>th</sup> annual event on November 16, 2016. SAGIS also provides custom training for interested parties from basic viewers to advanced analysis, guest lectures and support to local universities and schools, and teacher workshops and summer camp programs.
