## FEBRUARY 2020 CALL FOR PROJECTS

The Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (CORE MPO) is conducting a competitive project selection process to award allocated FY 2018 and 2019 Highway Infrastructure Program (HIP) funds, provided through the federal apportionments.

- Expected Available Funds:
  - FY 2018 HTP Funds = \$926,709 (federal portion) obligation deadline: September 30, 2021
  - FY 2019 HIP Funds = \$1,305,713 (federal portion) obligation deadline: September 30, 2022
- Maximum Award:
  - FY 2018 HIP Funds = \$926,709 (federal portion)
  - FY 2019 HIP Funds = \$1,305,713 (federal portion)
- Minimum Award = \$200,000 (federal portion)
- At least 20% of the eligible costs of the proposed project must be locally funded. (Previously incurred costs cannot be counted as part of the 20% match for the newly awarded federal funds. If the funds are used on interstates, it is a 90/10 match, and the funds are covered at 100% for certain safety projects.)

An applicant may request a minimum of *at least \$200,000 of federal funds*. The federal funding request in this application can represent no more than 80% of the total cost of the applicant's proposal for most projects. For example, if an applicant requests \$1,000,000, and provides no more than the required 20% local match, he/she would be submitting a proposal totaling \$1,250,000.

## Federal Requirements

Applicants should keep in mind that using the HIP funds involve adherence to federal requirements, as applicable, such as the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), prevailing wage rates (Davis-Bacon), Buy America, competitive bidding, and other contracting requirements, regardless of whether the projects are located within the right-of-way of a Federal-aid highway.

 Projects funded through this selection process must be located within the CORE MPO's Metropolitan Planning Area (MPA) boundary.

The CORE MPO - administered HIP funds can only be spent within the MPO's Metropolitan Planning Area which includes all of Chatham County, the portion of Effingham County and Bryan County located within the Savannah Urbanized Area, as well as Richmond Hill.

Projects, if awarded funds, will be programmed in FY 2020 or FY 2021 or FY 2022 in the CORE MPO's FY 2018 – 2021 Transportation Improvement Program (July 1, 2017 – June 30, 2021) or in FY 2021 – 2024 TIP (July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2024).

Once the project is programmed in the TIP and the awarded federal funding is authorized in the programmed fiscal year, the funds must be obligated within two years, otherwise the funds will lapse.

The project proposes to improve US 80/SR 26 from West of the Bull River to East of the Lazaretto Creek Bridge. The proposed replacement and widening of the existing bridges is to add wider paved shoulders for safety and to accommodate pedestrian and bicycle traffic.

The route is the only access to Tybee Island and serves as the only hurricane and emergency route.

The project is almost entirely within the boundary of the Fort Pulaski National Monument/Park.

There are proposed connections from the proposed bridges to the McQueen's Trail, which is an existing bicycle/pedestrian trail that runs parallel to this project.



Tybee Island requested to add the ROW phase to FY 2019 with local funds to expedite the project development process, and the ROW phase was moved to FY 2020 with a slight cost increase in June 2019. CST is in long range. In November 2018 GDOT requested to add additional Z001 funds for PE in FY 2019 and the funds have been authorized. In July 2019 GDOT requested to add additional HB 170 funds of \$1 million for PE in FY 2020. In November 2019 GDOT requested to increase the ROW cost from \$285,000 to \$1,203,000. 




# PROPOSED LUCATION (1-3)
