The Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (CORE MPO) is conducting a competitive project selection process to award expected FY 2023 - 2027 Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) Program Urban Attributable (Y230) funds, provided through the act entitled Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (Pub. L. 117-58, also known as the "Bipartisan Infrastructure Law" (BIL).

- Expected Available Funds:
 - \circ FY 2023 = \$9,750,122 (federal portion)
 - o FY 2024 = \$6,480,778 (federal portion)
 - o FY 2025 = \$4,000,000 (federal portion)
 - o FY 2026 = \$4,000,000 (federal portion)
 - o FY 2027 = \$4,000,000 (federal portion)
- Maximum Award for a project = available funds for that year (federal portion)
- Minimum Award for a Project = \$200,000 (federal portion)
- At least 20% of the eligible costs of the proposed project must be locally funded.

 (Previously incurred costs cannot be counted as part of the 20% match for the newly awarded federal funds.)

An applicant may request a minimum of *at least \$200,000 of federal funds*. The federal funding request in this application can represent no more than 80% of the total cost of the applicant's proposal. For example, if an applicant requests \$1,000,000, and provides no more than the required 20% local match, he/she would be submitting a proposal totaling \$1,250,000.

• Federal Requirements

Applicants should keep in mind that using the STBG funds involves adherence to federal requirements, as applicable, such as the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), prevailing wage rates (Davis-Bacon), Buy America, competitive bidding, and other contracting requirements, regardless of whether the projects are located within the right-of-way of a Federal-aid highway.

• Projects funded through this selection process must be located within the CORE MPO's Metropolitan Planning Area (MPA) boundary.

The CORE MPO - administered STBG Urban Attributable funds can only be spent within the MPO's Metropolitan Planning Area which includes all of Chatham County, the portion of Effingham County and Bryan County located within the Savannah Urbanized Area, as well as Richmond Hill.

Projects, if awarded funds in FY 2023 and FY 2024, will be programmed in the CORE MPO's FY 2021 – 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2024). Awarded projects in FY 2024 will be carried over to the FY 2024 – 2027 TIP as well. FY 2025 – 2027 funds will build the prioritized waiting list for projects to be included in the FY 2024 – 2027 TIP (revisit the prioritization during TIP development).



Once the project is programmed in the TIP and the awarded federal funding is authorized in the program year, the funds must be obligated within two years, otherwise the funds will be rescinded for use by other selected priority projects.

Proposal Description Summary	

The project was originated by the Coastal Region MPO (CORE) and Chatham County in response to the extension of SR 17 Connector/Jimmy DeLoach Parkway to I-16 (PI 522790) which opened to traffic in 2022. The extension of SR 17 Connector/Jimmy Deloach Parkway will increase traffic volumes and in particular truck volumes at the interchange. SR 17 Connector/Jimmy DeLoach Parkway will serve as the major thoroughfare to connect the Georgia Ports to I-16 and currently serves several industrial and intermodal sites associated with the Georgia Ports. With development projects ongoing, proposed, and expected along SR 17 Connector/Jimmy DeLoach Parkway and Little Neck Road, traffic volumes at the interchange are expected to grow by approximately 500% by 2050. The project is identified as project 2020-H-01 in the CORE MPO TIP. The draft concept report was submitted to GDOT in September 2022 and the current, preferred alternative is replacing the existing bridge with a new bridge and diverging diamond interchange.

This request is to fund right of way acquisition in FY2025 with anticipated construction let in FY2026.

The I-16 at SR 17 Connector/Jimmy DeLoach Parkway is an existing rural diamond interchange. The existing SR 17 Connector bridge over I-16 includes 2 lanes. I-16 east and west of the interchange is a 4-lane highway divided by a grass median. The I-16 ramps are currently operating as single lane roundabouts. SR 17 Connector/Jimmy DeLoach Parkway does not include sidewalks or bicycle lanes north or south of the interchange. Adjacent environmentally sensitive areas include wetlands, open waters, and non-buffered state waters. Existing utilities within the project include overhead electric distribution, underground communications and underground, water.

The proposed project will provide operational improvements at the existing I-16 @ SR 17 Connector/Jimmy Deloach Parkway interchange by adjusting ramp length and constructing a diverging diamond interchange. Signals will be constructed at the ramp intersections and the existing SR 17 Connector/Jimmy Deloach Parkway bridge over I-16 will be replaced. A 10-foot shared use path will be constructed on one side of SR 17 Connector/Jimmy Deloach Parkway within the project limits. Sidewalks, crosswalks, and ramps will be in compliance with ADA guidelines. The project is in Chatham County and City of Bloomingdale. The total length of the project is 0.7 miles. This project improves freight connection and access to GPA, improves truck mobility, replaces an aging bridge over the Interstate system and will include non-motorized transportation where current non-motorized infrastructure does not exist. Approval of the right of way funds will allow the project to continue on schedule for Let in FY2026.
