RE - Administrative Modifications to the FY 2021 -2024 TIP for Several Projects

Dear Mr. Caudill,

This letter is to acknowledge that the Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (CORE MPO) has received a request from the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) for administrative modifications to the FY 2021 – 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) regarding updating the project descriptions and maps for PI# 0017975 and PI# 0017976.

In addition, there are some updates to the new projects/studies that were programmed in the TIP in December 2022. PI#s were assigned to these new projects/studies in April 2023. The December 2022 and April 2023 TIP update resolutions signed by the CORE MPO Board Chairman are attached as a part of these modifications.






