



Updates to the FY 2021 – 2024 Transportation Improvement Program

April 2023

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is the MPO’s short-range programming document and is a staged, multi-year listing of surface transportation projects proposed for federal, state, and local funding within the metropolitan area. The TIP may be modified in accordance with the procedures outlined in the adopted Participation Plan by resolution of the CORE MPO Board if priorities, area goals, project schedules or funding levels change.

The current FY 2021 – 2024 TIP was adopted by the CORE MPO Board in December 2020 and is referenced in the Statewide TIP (STIP) which was signed by the Governor of Georgia in May 2021. The TIP has been updated in 2021 and 2022 through various amendments and administrative modifications.

It is important to make sure that the information contained in the TIP is current and reflective of the most up-to-date cost estimates and development schedules.

CORE MPO staff has coordinated with the project managers/sponsors on projects’ development status. Both GDOT and CAT have requested that some amendments be made to the TIP. It is important to amend the TIP to reflect these changes.

In addition, GDOT has assigned PI#s for the projects programmed in the TIP in December 2022 as a result from the 2022 Y230 and Y301 Calls for Projects. The PI#s have been added to the programmed projects administratively. The information is shown only as a reference.

The following summary outlines the changes to the FY 2021 – 2024 TIP for April 2023.

AMENDMENT PROCESS FOR FY 2021 – FY 2024 TIP

It should be noted that the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) must be consistent with the current 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) called Mobility 2045. Before amendments can be made to the FY 2021 - 2024 TIP, MTP/TIP consistency must be verified. The TIP must also be conformant to the Performance Based Planning and Programming (PBPP).

The project updates are outlined on the next pages. Updated TIP project pages/tables for these projects are illustrated in Appendix A. Projects/Phases requiring amendments, as opposed to administrative modifications, to the TIP require a 15-day public review and comment period.

Public Participation Process

The adopted TIP/STIP amendment process outlined in the CORE MPO's Participation Plan requires public review and comment and responses to all comments (either individually or in summary form) for all TIP amendments. To process the proposed updates in April 2023, CORE MPO advertised a fifteen (15) day public comment period in the Savannah Morning News on Sunday, April 9, 2023 (Appendix B). The notice was sent to the local news media and the consultation agencies as well as neighborhood associations and posted on the CORE MPO website. The comment period started on April 12, 2023 and closed on April 26, 2023. A public hearing was advertised, and it was held in conjunction with the CORE MPO Board meeting on April 26, 2023. Comments and questions received during the public review and comment period were addressed as they came in.

CORE MPO Actions

The proposed updates to the FY 2021 – 2024 TIP were endorsed by the CORE MPO Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) on April 19, by the Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) on April 20, and by the Advisory Committee on Accessible Transportation (ACAT) on April 24, 2023. The CORE MPO Board approved the TIP updates on April 26, 2023.

Chatham Area Transit – Savannah Belles Ferry System - Ferry Vessel Construction	
MTP Priority	The project is consistent with transit improvements of Mobility 2045.
Project Description:	CAT was awarded \$1,800,000 T-HUD funds for the construction of a hybrid vessel in March 2023. The vessel is the third of three that will begin construction in Calendar Year 2023. CAT will receive funding at 32.7% federal level, 54.5% state level and will provide the 12.8% local match. The Savannah Belles Ferry System provides water transportation services across the Savannah River to Hutchinson Island. It provides water transportation to jobs, the Savannah Convention Center and other places of business in addition to enhancing the tourism experience.
Project Status:	CAT was awarded a T-HUD \$1,800,000 appropriation and is awaiting the approval of a \$3,000,000 Georgia Transit Trust Fund award for the construction of a third new ferry vessel.

Project Description:	Chatham Area Transit recognizes the importance of transit in serving the multimodal transportation needs of our residents and visitors to travel to the places they need and want to go. Our desire to be a strong partner in the region’s multimodal system providing exceptional ADA transit services requires continued investment in our CAT Mobility program and facility needs. Chatham Area Transit will locate a new paratransit and maintenance facility in the southern to western portion of Chatham County, which will improve access, reduce wait time, decrease congestion, and improve upon preventative maintenance for our paratransit customers and citizens. It would afford space for additional bus parking, expanded travel training, and future low emissions electrification of the Chatham Area Transit vehicle fleet.

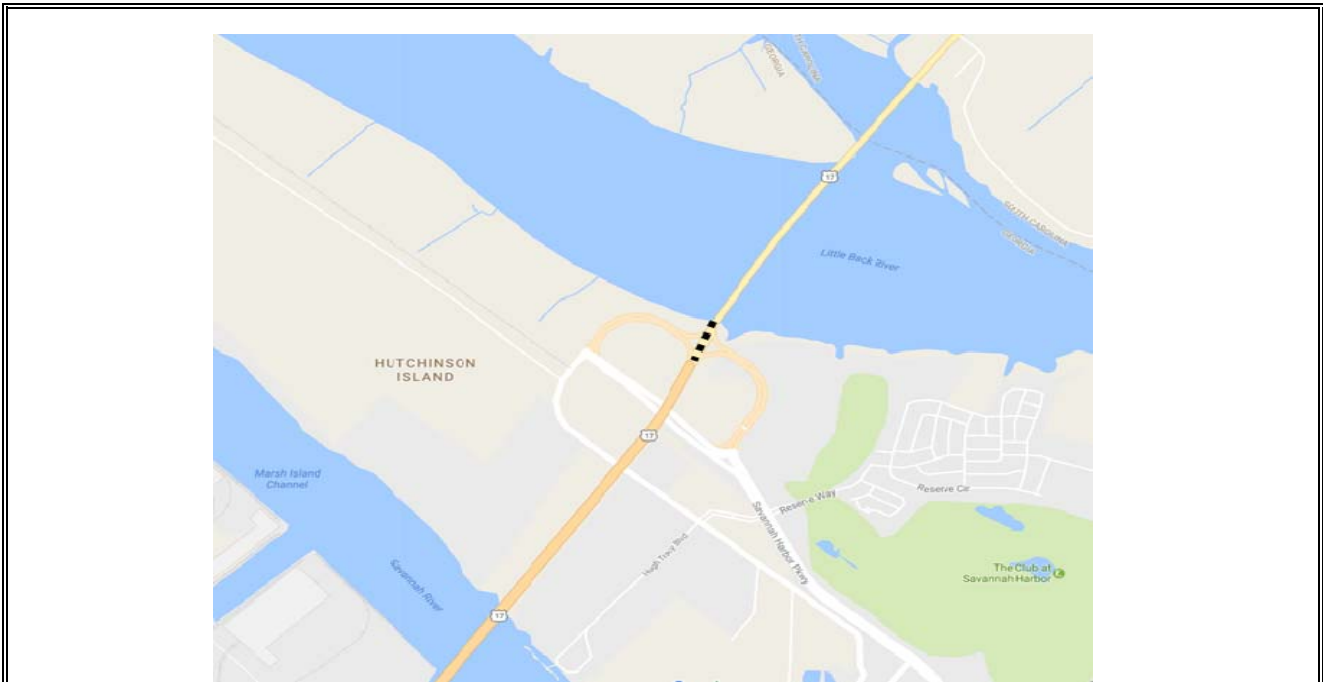

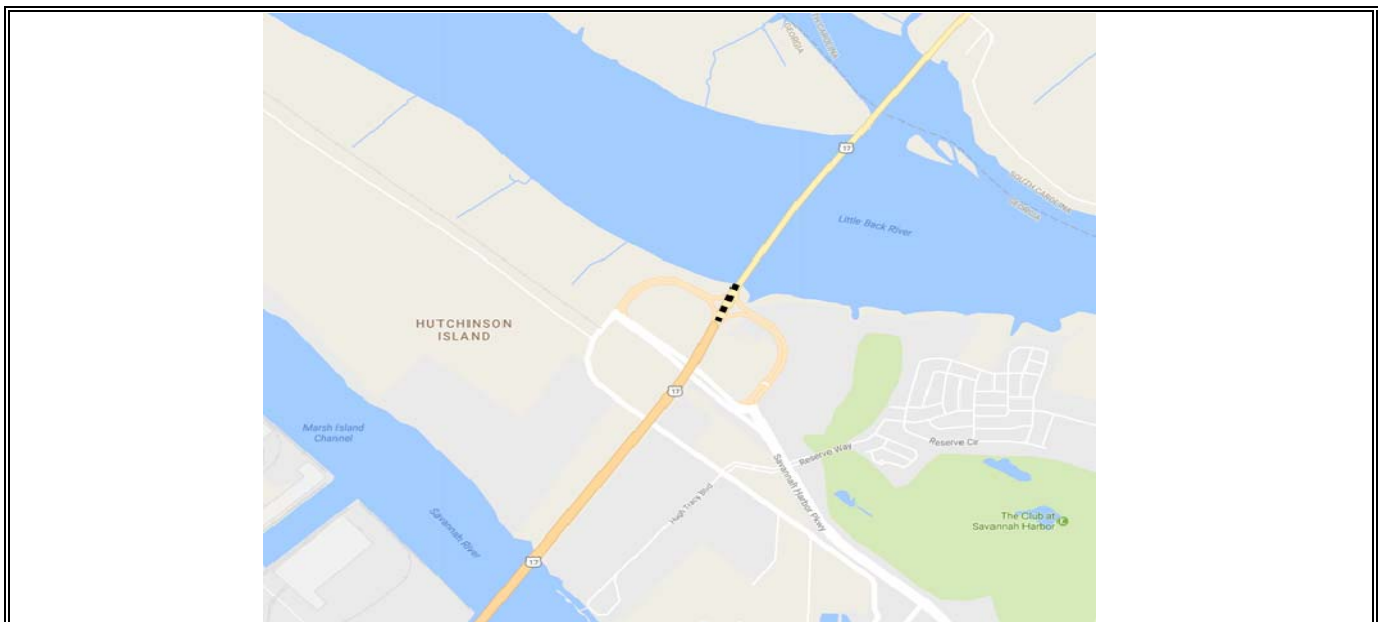
PROJECT LOCATION

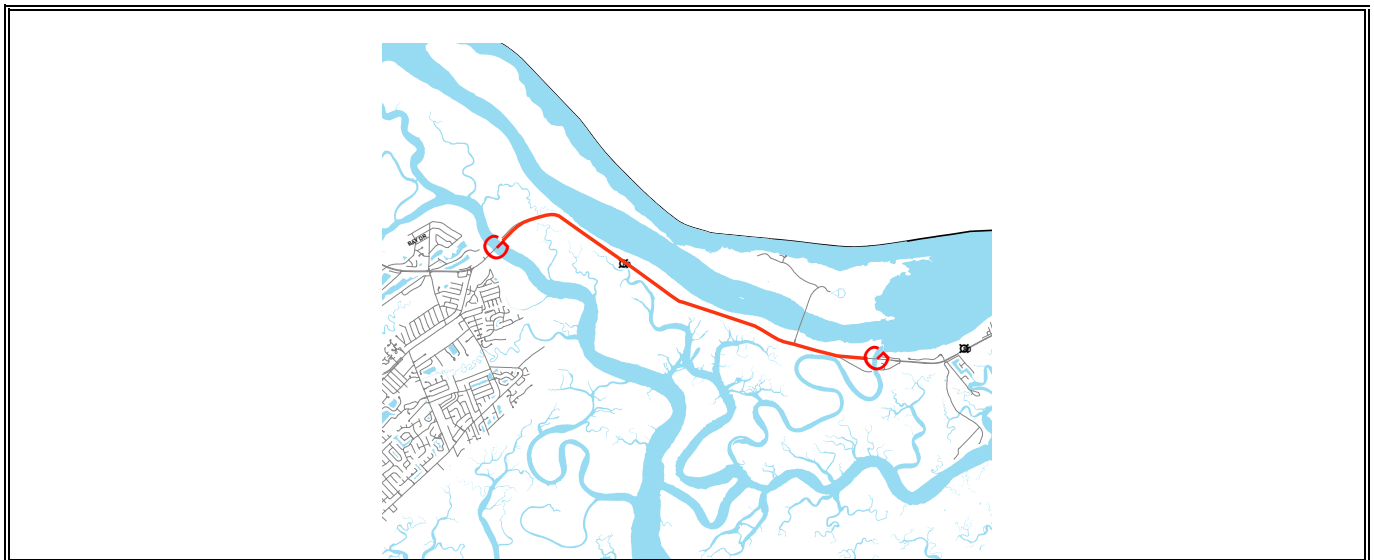
PROJECT LOCATION

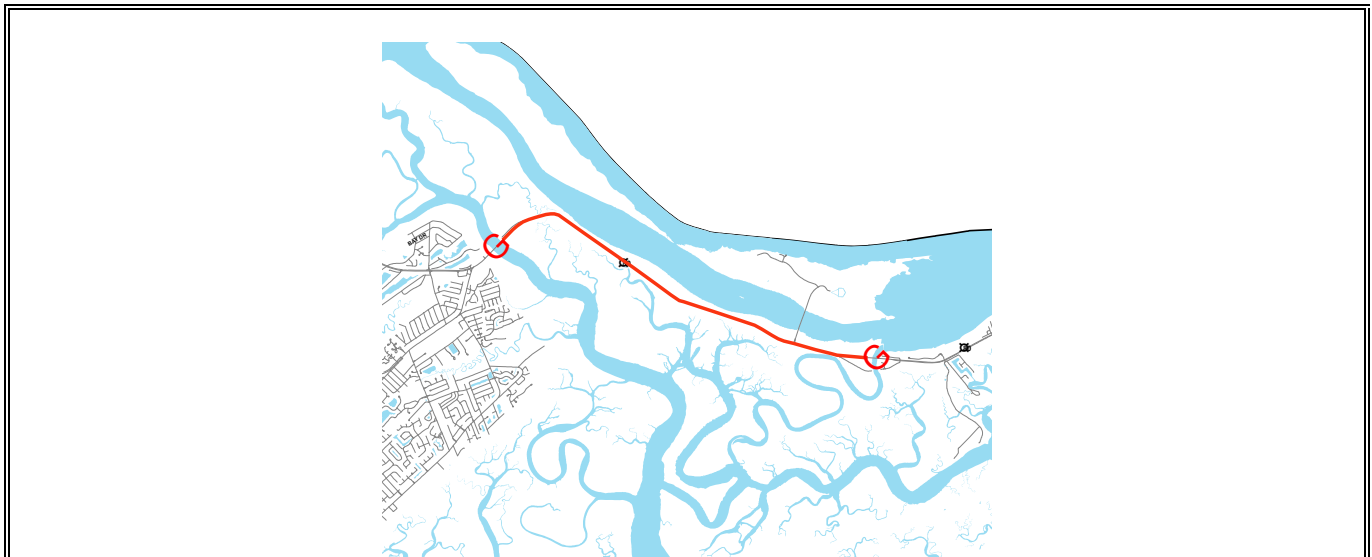
