



**Resolution to Amend the FY 2024 – 2027 Transportation Improvement Program of  
the Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (CORE MPO)**

**WHEREAS**, the Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (CORE MPO) has been designated by the Governor of Georgia as the Metropolitan Planning Organization of the Savannah urbanized area in accordance with federal requirements of Title 23, Section 134 of the United States Code to have a cooperative, comprehensive, and continuing transportation planning process; and

**WHEREAS**, CORE MPO adopted the FY 2024 – 2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) on November 1, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, CORE MPO desires to adopt amendments to the FY 2024 - 2027 TIP for the CORE MPO Metropolitan Planning Area to reflect the updated information and the latest developments; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed TIP amendments include updates to several highway and transit projects as outlined in the TIP amendment staff report;

**WHEREAS**, CORE MPO has completed the public review and comment period for the proposed TIP amendments according to the Participation Plan and addressed all comments received; and

**WHEREAS**, CORE MPO has conducted a public hearing for the proposed amendments, and has taken into consideration comments made at the public hearing; and

**WHEREAS**, all requirements of the Participation Plan pertaining to TIP amendments and administrative modifications have been met.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization approves the proposed amendments to the FY 2024 - 2027 Transportation Improvement Program as shown in the summary of TIP amendment staff report with any corrections based upon the motion of June 26, 2024.

## **Amendments to FY 2024 – 2027 Transportation Improvement Program**

**June 2024**

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is the MPO's short-range programming document and is a staged, multi-year listing of surface transportation projects proposed for federal, state, and local funding within the metropolitan area. The TIP may be modified in accordance with the procedures outlined in the adopted Participation Plan by resolution of the CORE MPO Board if priorities, area goals, project schedules or funding levels change.

The current FY 2024 – 2027 TIP was adopted by the CORE MPO Board on November 1, 2023 and is referenced in the Statewide TIP (STIP). It is important to make sure that the information contained in the TIP is current and reflective of the most up-to-date cost estimates and development schedules. CORE MPO staff has coordinated with the project managers/sponsors on projects' development status. It is also important to amend the TIP to add new or delete existing projects/phases at the request of sponsoring agencies based on the project changes and MTP/TIP consistencies.

In April and May of 2024, Chatham Area Transit (CAT) requested multiple TIP amendments be made. In May 2024, the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) requested amendments be made to two highway projects. For CAT, these TIP amendments included adding two new ferry projects, and increasing cost estimates under the Section 5307 program. For GDOT, the amendments included adding ROW phase and moving CST phase for the SR 404 SPUR/US 17 from Savannah River to Back River project and moving ROW and CST phases for the SR 26/US 80 @ Lazaretto Creek project. The following summary outlines the proposed changes to the FY 2024 - 2027 TIP.

## AMENDMENT PROCESS FOR FY 2024 – FY 2027 TIP

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) must be consistent with the current 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) called Mobility 2045. Before any amendments can be made to the FY 2024 - 2027 TIP, MTP/TIP consistency must be verified. The TIP must also be conformant to the Performance Based Planning and Programming (PBPP).

Projects/Phases requiring amendments, as opposed to administrative modification, to the TIP require a 15-day public review and comment period.

## PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

The adopted TIP/STIP amendment process outlined in the CORE MPO's Participation Plan requires public review and comment and responses to all comments (either individually or in summary form) for all TIP amendments. To process the proposed amendments in June 2024, CORE MPO advertised a fifteen (15) day public comment period in the Savannah Morning News on Sunday, June 9, 2024 (Appendix B). The notice was sent to the local news media and the consultation agencies as well as neighborhood associations and posted on the CORE MPO website. The comment period started on June 12, 2024 and closed on June 26, 2024. No written comments on the proposed TIP amendments have been received. Verbal comments have been addressed on the floor at the June CORE MPO Board and advisory committee meetings.

## CORE MPO Actions

The proposed amendments to the FY 2024-2027 TIP were endorsed by the CORE MPO Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) on June 20, 2024. The CORE MPO Board approved the TIP amendments on June 26, 2024.

Project Description:	Federal law (23 U.S.C. § 104(f); 49 U.S.C. § 5334(i)(1)) allows Federal-Aid Highway Program funding made available for public transportation projects to be flexed (or transferred) to be administered by FTA for public transportation projects. The project is a dock rehab.
Project Status:	In April 2024, CAT requested to amend a project into the FY 2024 - 2027 TIP. This project's construction phase has been programmed for FY 2025. The total cost is \$454,115. The federal portion of that amount is \$363,292 and the local portion is \$90,823. The funds for the project originally come from FHWA and were programmed in previous TIPs. After funding authorization, the funds have been flexed to FTA and became FTA funds. The project needs to be shown in the transit TIP before CAT can access the funds.

This project is a ferry replacement project.
Project Status:	In April 2024, CAT requested to amend a project into the 2024 - 2027 TIP. This project's construction phase has been programmed for FY 2025. The total cost is \$6,000,000. The federal portion of that amount is \$1,118,528 from flex funds and \$1,800,000 from THUD funds. The local match for the flex funds is \$279,632.23 (required 20% match, coming from the GDOT Transit Trust Fund (State)). The local match for the THUD funds is \$450,000 (required 20% match), coming from the Georgia Transit Trust Fund (State). Additional match of \$2,270,367.77 comes from the Georgia Transit Trust Fund (State) and 81,471.09 from local sources.

Project Description:	SCDOT in cooperation with FHWA and GDOT, proposes widening and improvements of U.S. 17 from Hutchinson Island in Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia to South Carolina (S.C.) 315 located southwest of Bluffton, South Carolina. Approximately 3,000 feet of the project corridor is located in Chatham County, Georgia. The proposed improvements include the widening of U.S. 17 from two to four travel lanes, divided by a grassed median.
Project Status:	The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) is widening US 17 in coordination with the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT). This portion is located in Chatham County, Georgia. The project is included in CORE MPO's Mobility 2045, Cost Band One. PE funds have been authorized. ROW is to be determined. CST is programmed in FY 2025 with Y800 funds. In May 2024, GDOT requested to add the ROW phase in FY 2025 with Y800 funds of \$500,000. The federal portion is \$400,000 and the state portion is \$100,000. GDOT also requested to move the CST phase from FY 2025 to FY 2026 without cost estimate updates.

Project Description:	The project would replace the bridge at Lazaretto Creek with a two-lane bridge that includes bike and pedestrian improvements.
Project Status:	This project is split from PI# 0010560. PE funds have been authorized. It was awarded HIP (Z919) funds in FY 2023 for ROW, but the ROW phase has been moved to FY 2024. The City of Tybee Island will provide the 20% local match. CST is programmed in FY 2025 with Y800 funds. In April 2024, the HIP funds have been re-allocated to another project through a TIP administrative modification. In May 2024, GDOT requested to move the CST phase with Y800 funds from FY 2025 to FY 2028 without cost estimate update. The total amount of Y800 CST funds is \$20,798,854. The federal portion is \$16,639,083 and the state portion is \$4,159,771. GDOT also requested to move the ROW phase from FY 2024 to FY 2026 with updated cost estimates and funding sources.
Amendment:	Move the CST phase with Y800 funds from FY 2025 to FY 2028 (deleting the phase from the TIP); and move the ROW phase from FY 2024 to FY 2026 with cost estimate and funding source updates.
PBPP:	This project will help achieve the performance targets for Highway Safety (PM1) and Pavement and Bridge Condition (PM2).

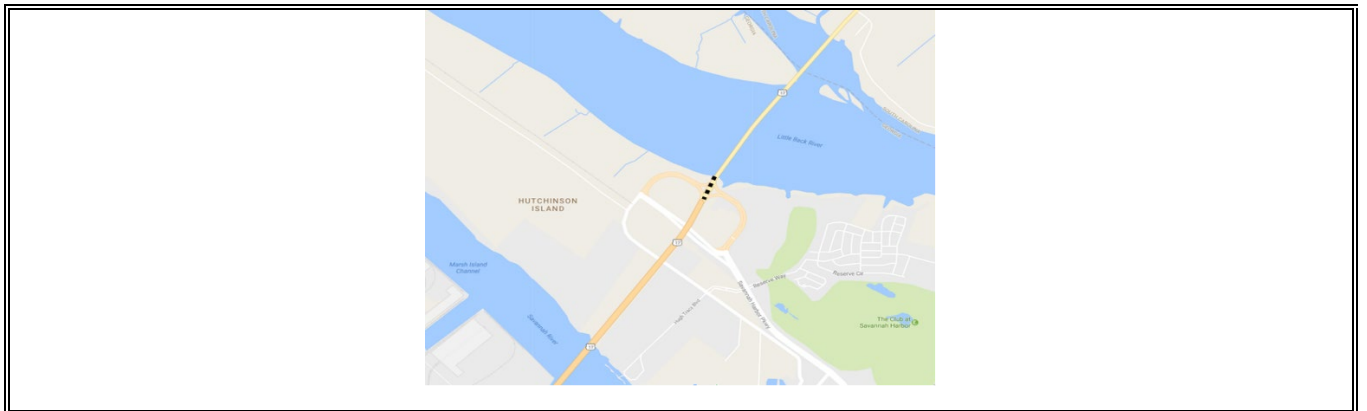

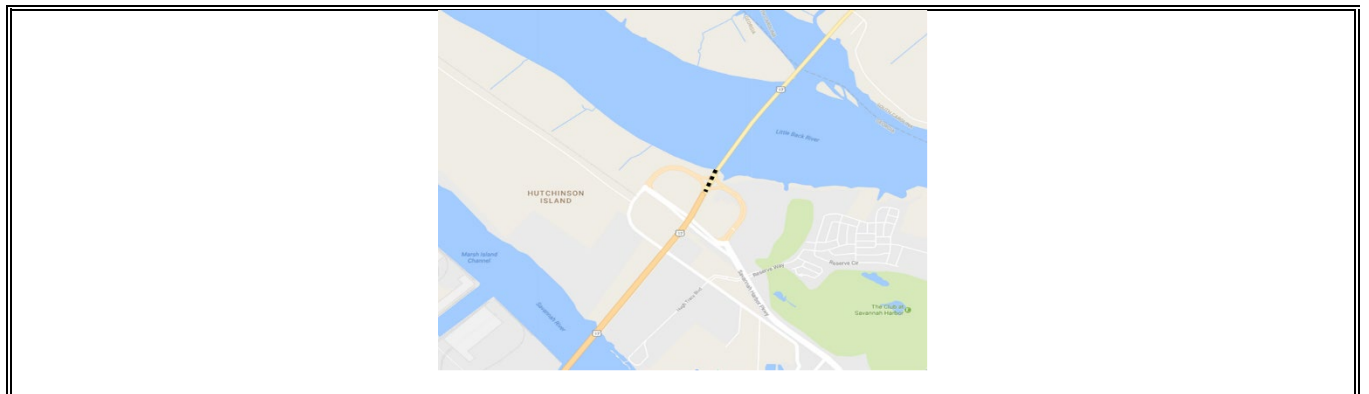
