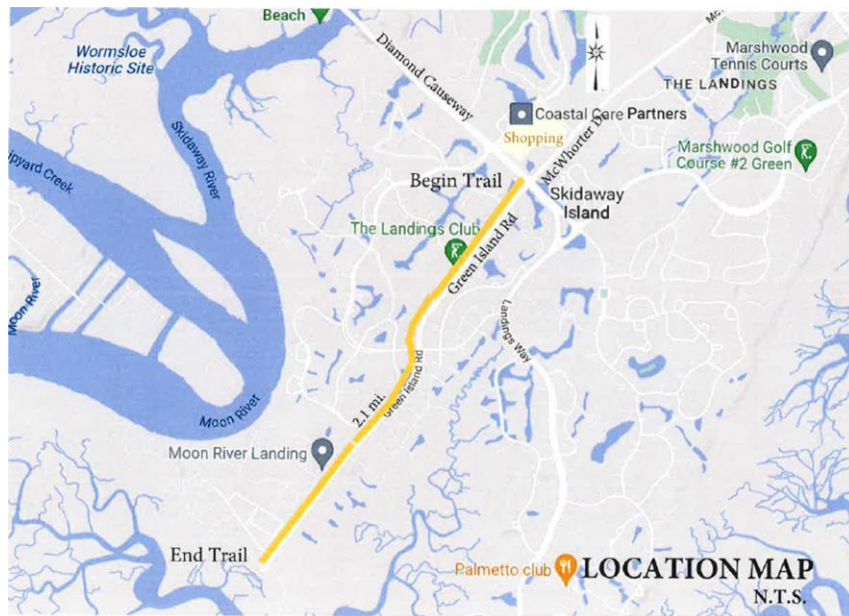

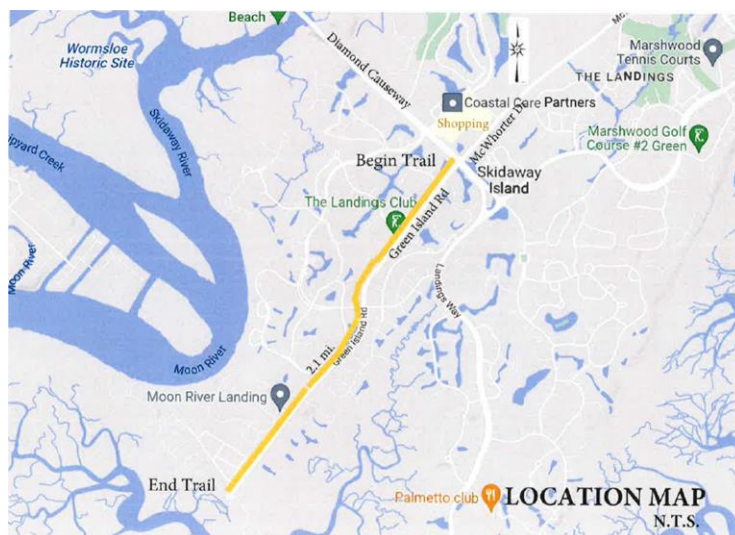

Subject: Dec 2022 CORE TIP Amendment Clarifications

Good morning CORE team,

I met with our programming outfit yesterday, and they are in the final stretch of getting it processed.

The points they need clarification on:

- Please confirm the map for the Middleground Road Phase of the Tide to Town Trail Network
 - There was some confusion on this project because the street changes names after a specific curve and there are some weird environmental issues around calling things "trails."
- Please send a rough map (MS paint is fine) of where the sidewalks will be along Ivey and Linwood
 - They need this for digitization of the project's footprint

They wanted me to pass on that the Green Island Multipurpose Trail will be described as a "path" rather than a "trail" on our side, as apparently inclusion of that word has triggered a lot of unnecessary environmental work / financial outlay in the recent past. Everything can be kept the same in CORE's TIP, they just wanted all of us to be aware of that nuance.

Wykoda / Jasmine – For the CAT bus project, does this need to be flexed to FTA? Programming asked that, and it sounds right to me. I know there has been some turnover at CAT, so there may not be a lot of awareness of this maneuver over there right now.

I will be out the rest of today as I have family coming into town this afternoon, but I can be reached via phone if you need additional info from me.
