
PORTS / INTERMODAL





Freight moving through the ports in the study area accounts for 2.1% of all tonnage and 1.5% of the freight value.

Intermodal and mixed mode movements account for 24.5% of all tonnage and 20.2% of the total freight value in the study area.



The Port of Savannah has two terminals: Ocean and Garden City

- ⇒ There have been over 2,000 vessel calls made to the Port of Savannah in 2012
- ⇒ Both terminals have depth of 42 feet and width of 500 feet
- ⇒ Garden City is the 4th largest container storage port in the US
- ⇒ Ocean provides break bulk and Ro-Ro services

The Savannah Harbor Expansion Project

- ⇒ Deepening the Savannah channel to up to 48 feet
- ⇒ New infrastructure and equipment

There are two intermodal centers servicing the study area

- ⇒ Cordele Intermodal Center uses rail access to the Port of Savannah
- ⇒ CenterPoint Intermodal Center offers rail access to Norfolk Southern
