




## **August 2013 Fact Sheet**

#### **Study Background**

State Route (SR) 21 is a major thoroughfare in northern Chatham County. It provides a primary means of access to regional industries, distribution centers and the Port of Savannah. The corridor also serves regional and commuter traffic, linking Port Wentworth, Effingham County and South Carolina with Garden City and the City of Savannah.






#### **Study Objectives**

- Develop a viable and constructible concept that will improve capacity along the corridor, reduce congestion, and improve safety while maintaining the character and cohesion of the community
- Obtain community input throughout the process to develop and evaluate alternatives to define a preferred alternative supported by the community.

### **Study Results**

Over the course of the study, many alternatives were developed, analyzed, and shared with the community for feedback. Based on the technical analysis and public input, Alternative 10 (shown to the right) has been identified as the preferred alternative.
