Summary: The City of Pooler is the project manager and will coordinate with the City of Garden City, the City of Bloomingdale, the City of Savannah, Unincorporated Chatham County as well as CORE MPO to conduct the study.

The Kick-off meeting was held July 29, 2022 with Kimley Horn, City of Pooler, GDOT, Chatham County, and the CORE MPO staff. The goals and objectives were presented.

- Identify and prioritize short-term and long-term improvement projects needed for the SR 26/US 80 corridor to operate at an acceptable level of service.
- Prioritize recommended improvements to facilitate planning and programming of projects through the Coastal Region Metropolitan planning organization metropolitan transportation plan process.
- Justify the future programming of projects in the CORE MPO’s transportation Improvement Program and Mobility 2045 Plan.
