Ms. Wykoda Wang, with CORE MPO stated that the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) insisted that GPA be reinstated as a voting member of the CORE MPO Board. The Port had suggested being an advisory member last year during MPO reapportionment because they did not wish to participate in the MPO dues structure. The MPO Chairman and staff are coordinating with GPA to achieve this reinstatment. The MOU and Bylaws need to be revised to not this change.
