I am especially pleased with the interns who will be assisting us this year. Although you will learn more about the interns and their duties during the Planning Meeting; however, briefly, here is an overview:

- Catherine Dewitt, sophomore at Auburn University, working with
 Jackie Jackson Teel to produce materials for the Coastal Stormwater Management
 Manual. She is also drafting a how-to guide for sustainable building for
 homeowners. During her time in SAGIS, Ms. Dewitt will also catalogue
 historical air photos to create an index of the MPC repository of air photos.
- Quartavius Swanson and William Roundtree, seniors at Savannah State
 University. Both young men will be helping to create a County Greenspace map
 through GIS that will identify all protected areas and parks that exist within
 Chatham County. They will also be researching conservation easements that are
 held in the County and the conservation status of each protected area.
- Michelle Knowland, Minnesota native and graduate student of public policy at the University of Minnesota's Humphrey Institute of Public Affairs, will be assisting Dennis Hutton and Jack Butler with their work on community development and land use plans for the West Bay Street Corridor and Hudson Hill.
