The petitioner is requesting approval of an amended Master Plan for the purpose of increasing the lot area coverage for all lots, reducing the development setbacks, relocating the condominium buildings, and establishing a public boat ramp.

Mr. Plumbley presented the staff report and asked that the ten-acre tract of land known as the Tide Gate not be discussed today. This would eliminate Condition #2 in the conditions for recommended staff approval. The Tide Gate parcel is not presently controlled by the petitioner. The MPC will be given an opportunity to review and comment when a development plan is proposed for the parcel.

Mr. Ragsdale suggested removal of paragraph 1, sub-paragraph 5; paragraph 8; and paragraph 10 from the Findings section of the staff report. He also recommended any graphics pertaining to the master plans reflect the removal of the boat ramp.

Mr. Farmer asked for further explanation regarding the retail space.

Mr. Plumbley explained that, as proposed, retail space would be limited to 1,500 square feet in two buildings; one on each side of the Tide Gate tract totaling 3,000 square feet. There would be limited signage.

Mr. Farmer asked if those specifications were of petitioner's request or were limitations imposed?

Mr. Plumbley replied it was the petitioner's request.

Ralph Forbes of Thomas and Hutton Engineering Company, introduced himself as a representative of the petitioner and offered to answer any questions. There were none.

John McCleskey, Project Director of Savannah Harbor, stated he saw the plan about a week prior to the meeting. He stated he'd like to go on record as meeting the developer and hopes the project is successful.

#### **Board Action:**

The MPC staff recommends <b>approval</b> of the amended Master Plan which does not include the Tide Gate Tract with regard to any discussion or vote. The Staff Report shall be amended to eliminate the reference to the Tide Gate Tract or possible improvements to the Tide Gate Tract. Staff Report amendments are: Finding 1, section 5 to be stricken; Finding 8 to be stricken in its entirety; Finding 10 to be stricken in its entirety. Staff Recommendation Approval Condition #2 to be stricken in its entirety.	- PASS
