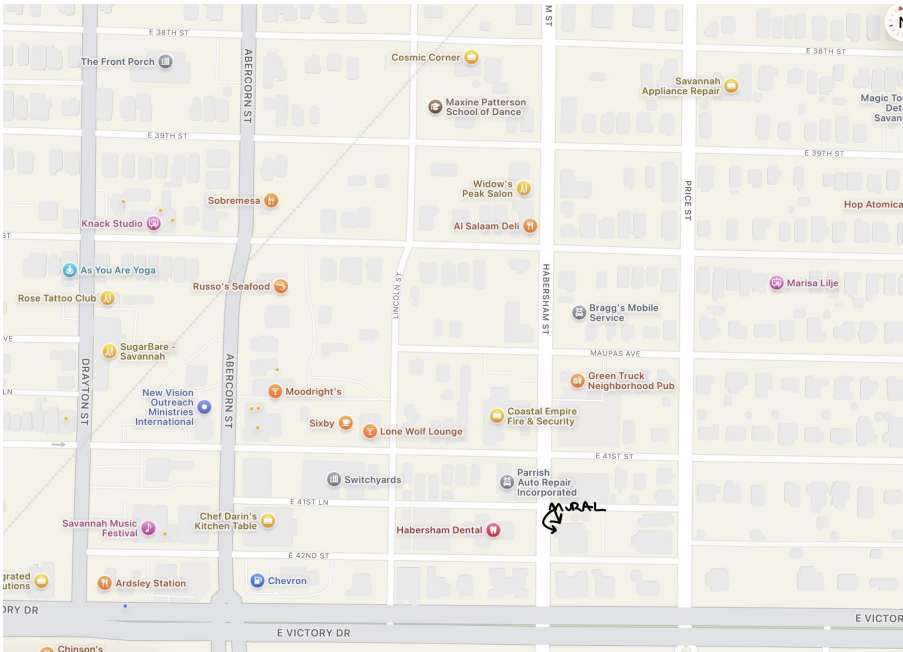
Materials: professional exterior-grade, UV-protected house paint.

Rather than demanding attention, the flowing ivy and floral elements are intended to blend into the surrounding environment, creating a calm visual presence that reflects the area's lush canopy and pedestrian-friendly atmosphere.
