Blue Star Memorials represent all those serving in the service, have served or will serve.

Gold Star Memorials honor those who served and made the ultimate sacrifice, their lives.

If you consider Savannah rich in history, you can't forget its rich military history too.

From Shermans March to sea during the Civil War, to the nod to WWI's longest palm lined drive on Victory Drive to our own Blue Star Memorials at the Landings, the Veterans Tiny Homes and the entrance to Hunter Army Airfield. The latter, a project which began at the end of WWII.

With only 22 Gold Star Memorials in the State of Georgia, this will be the first of its kind in the lower part of Georgia. And it stands to reason the first double ceremony as well. Our Garden Club has worked diligently and are very proud to fund and bring this honor to the Veterans Memorial Park. It will be a beautiful salute to the already posted American Flag which we greatly appreciate.
